MODULE STRUCTURE

PHASE 1: GERMAN LANGUAGE AND COMMUNICATION SKILLS – 13 MONTHS

Objective: Build linguistic competence for healthcare communication.

Content:

- German A1 levels (CEFR framework)
- German vocabulary and patient interaction
- Grammar, pronunciation, and writing practice
- Role-play and case-based dialogues in clinical settings

Methodology

- Online and offline classes
- Interactive sessions with native speakers
- Audio-visual learning tools and digital exercises

PHASE 2: GERMAN CULTURE AND HEALTHCARE ORIENTATION – 12 MONTHS

Objective: Develop cultural understanding and system awareness.

Content:

- German social norms, values, and workplace culture
- Overview of the German healthcare system
- Roles and responsibilities of healthcare professionals
- Patient rights, ethics, and confidentiality in Germany
- Intercultural communication and adaptation strategies

Methodology:

- Virtual cultural immersion sessions
- Guest lectures by German healthcare professionals
- Case studies and group discussions

PHASE 3: GERMAN CULTURE AND HEALTHCARE ORIENTATION – 12 MONTHS

Objective: Prepare for professional transition and employment.


Content:

- Recognition of foreign qualifications (Anerkennung process)
- Application and interview preparation
- Resume and motivation letter writing in German
- Licensing procedures for doctors, nurses, and therapists
- Internship and job placement guidance

Methodology:

- Mentorship and counseling sessions
- Mock interviews and document review
- Collaboration with German partner institutions

CLASS STRUCTURE

60 MINUTES - 1 MODULE



Begrüßung und Einführung (Greeting and Introduction) - 10 Minutes

- Warm welcome and short introduction round in German: Wie heißt du? Woher kommst du?
- Overview of class objectives and expected outcomes.
- Brief cultural note: Importance of greetings in German culture (Guten Morgen, Guten Tag, Guten Abend).

Grundelemente der deutschen Sprache (Basic Elements of German) - 15 Minutes

- Introduction to the German alphabet and pronunciation.
- Practice of special characters: ä, ö, ü, ß.
- Basic sentence structure: Subject-Verb-Object.
- Common verbs: sein (to be), haben (to have), kommen (to come).
- Example sentences:
- Ich bin Student.
- Du hast ein Buch.
- Er kommt aus Indien.

Interaktive Übung (Interactive Practice) - 15 Minutes

- Pair or group activity: forming simple dialogues.
- Role-play: Introducing oneself and asking basic questions.
- Wie heißt du?
- Ich heiße Maria.
- Wo wohnst du?
- Ich wohne in Bonn.
- Listening and repetition exercises for pronunciation improvement.

Kulturelle Elemente (Cultural Elements) - 10 Minutes

- Short discussion on German customs and daily expressions.
- Introduction to polite forms: Sie vs. du.
- Overview of German punctuality and communication style.
- Mini cultural quiz to reinforce learning.

Zusammenfassung und Feedback (Summary and Feedback) - 10 Minutes

- Recap of key vocabulary and grammar points.
- Quick oral quiz to assess understanding.
- Open discussion: what was easy, what was challenging.
- Homework: Write a short self-introduction in German (5–6 sentences).

Learning Outcomes

- Ability to greet and introduce oneself in German.
- Understanding of basic sentence structure and pronunciation.
- Familiarity with essential verbs and vocabulary.
- Awareness of German cultural norms and communication etiquette.
- Confidence to engage in simple German conversations.

Nutzung von Tagesschau für aktuelle Themen (Using Tagesschau for Current Affairs) – 5 Minutes

- Learners are encouraged to watch short clips or read articles from Tagesschau, Germany's leading news platform, to stay updated on current events.
- This practice helps improve listening comprehension, expand vocabulary, and understand how German is used in real-life contexts.
- Discussing selected news topics in class promotes awareness of German society, politics, and culture while strengthening language skills.

Einsatz deutscher Dokumentarfilme (Using German Documentaries) - 5 Minutes

- Incorporating short segments from German documentaries enhances listening and comprehension skills through exposure to authentic speech and diverse accents.
- Documentaries on topics such as history, science, and daily life in Germany provide cultural depth and context to language learning.
- Students analyze key vocabulary, expressions, and themes from the films, fostering both linguistic and cultural understanding.


